

## Cleaning protocol following COVID-19

In this document we indicate which measures we take when cleaning our B&B and holiday homes to minimize contamination with Covid 19.

### Fresh air:

Half an hour before we start cleaning we open all windows, doors and ventilation grids. These also remain open during cleaning.

### Disposable or reuse:

During cleaning we use paper and/or disinfectant wipes, which are thrown away immediately after use. All reusable wipes are washed at a minimum of 60 degrees Celsius.

### Clean first, then disinfect:

Cleaning is the removal of dirt and disinfection is the killing of germs with chemicals. We clean with water and detergents and for disinfection we use cleaning products with alcohol or a diluted household bleach.

### Fabrics and soft surfaces:

The house has sofas, rugs and curtains. These are cleaned according to the cleaning instructions of the materials.

### Linen:

The linen (kitchen towels, duvet cover, towels and sheets) is washed at 90 degrees Celsius.

### Cleaning checklist for touch-sensitive surfaces:

#### Rooms

- Beds, chairs, tables and benches
- (Night) cabinets
- Loose decorative objects, vases, dishes, etc.
- Light switches, reading lamps and floor lamps
- Clothes hangers
- Remote controls / TV

#### Bathroom:

- Toilets
- Shower, bath, sink and taps
- Shower curtain
- Care products (shampoo, soap, soap pump)
- Towel radiator
- Hair dryer
- Mirror

#### kitchen

- Sink / sink and faucet
- Kitchen appliances (oven, microwave, toaster, coffee maker, etc.)
- Cooking materials (spatulas, cutlery, plates, dishes, etc.)
- Spices and cooking supplies (herbs, oil, storage trays)
- Dustbin
- Cleaning supplies (vacuum cleaner, bucket, mop, cleaning agent)

#### Others

- Entertainment and information (magazines, books, games, etc.)
- Children's items (toys, high chair, cot)
- Keys
- Door handles, banisters, handles windows, cabinets and light switches
- Thermostats
- Floors
